Entry Level Challenge

Twisted Tales and Rhymes

This is a verbal challenge. You will have 2 minutes to think and 3 minutes to respond. Each of you will be given a Pass card. When it is your turn, you will respond or you may use your pass card, putting it into a container in the center of your group. If there are five members of your team, then all five must participate. You may not talk to each other at any time, but you may ask questions, however, time will continue. You will respond in order, beginning with the person of the team's choice.

Scoring: Your team will receive 1 point for common problem and 5 points for a creative or humorous response. Your team will receive 3 points for each unused Pass card.

Your verbal challenge is: You are to make a change in a familiar nursery rhyme or fairy tale. For example, you might say, "Little Boy Blue, come blow your clarinet," or "The glass slipper didn't fit Cinderella's foot." Your team may use each nursery rhyme or fairy tale ONLY ONCE.

(Coaches: If you find that your team has difficulty with this, have them brainstorm out loud as many fairy tales or rhymes as they can think of...then try it again. During their thinking time, each member should think of a minimum of 6 fabulous, funny, crazy answers, and then they MUST rehearse them in their mind, and visually 'see' their answers written on their fingers. If they do this, they will retain those fabulous answers, so they can get a terrific score! You will know if they have not used their thinking time to their best advantage if their first 5 rounds are not mostly 5 point answers.)
